- Variety of paper for dry and wet media
- Graphite pencils (variety HB, 2B, 4B, 6B, 9B)
- Water-soluble colored pencils or crayons
- Range of erasers (kneaded, white, pink pearl)
- Brushes (recommended one that hold water)
- Travel watercolor paints
- Travel water dispenser brush
- Small portable pallet for mixing
- Small jars with lids for water
- Masking fluid (optional)
- Masking or artist tape
- Pencil sharpener
