Virtual Class: Introduction to PanPastels

Students are asked to bring the following supplies

PanPastels Option #1

- PanPastels Introductory Set of 5 colors, including Hansa Yellow, Permanent Red, Ultramarine Blue, Black and White
 - o Note: this set or the individual colors are available anywhere PanPastels are sold
- 1 Pkg of 2 SOFFT large Angle Slice Sponge Applicators
 - Note: this sponge is designed for use with PanPastels and is available where PanPastels are sold

PanPastels Options #2

- "The Color Wheel set of 12 PanPastels, which includes the 5 colors in the introductory set (above) + 7 more PanPastel colors (Orange, Magenta, Phthalo Blue, Permanent Green, Violet, Turquoise, and Diarylide Yellow)
- 1 package of Large Angle Slice Sponge Applicator, + PanPastel tray and cover for 20 PanPastels.
 - Note: this option as a packaged set is available only through Dakota Art Pastels for students of Dawn Emerson Workshops (request discount upon ordering by phone)
- Items are available separately where PanPastels are sold.

Paper

- 10-20 sheets smooth (untextured) white Sketch Paper- preferably 18x24" size (or no smaller than 14x17").
 - The instructor will be using Stonehenge Printmaking Paper and an 18x24" pad of Strathmore Printmaking 300 series paper of 30 sheets, but you may use any paper you have available.

Misc





- Flat Razor Blades
- Masking Tape
- Black Ink: Small bottle Sumi or permanent black ink and small dish& bowl for ink and water
- Brushes: Flat brush or sponge brush on stick (1/2"and/or 1" wide)
- Paper Towels
- 2 types of Erasers: 1 kneaded eraser, 1 Mars Plastic eraser
- Small assortment of Stick Pastels
 - Instructor uses soft pastels like Great American, half sticks of Blue Earth, half sticks of Sennelier, half sticks of Schminke, Diane Townsend Terrages, etc.
 - If you do not have soft sticks, and only have hard pastels like Rembrandt, that is fine.
 - Note: half stick sets come without wrappers. If your stick pastels have paper wrappers please remove the wrappers before class.
- Cutting surface
- Stencils: several thin, plastic stencils with patterns or other materials with patterns like punchitella, doilies, etc.
- Roll of clear packaging tape
- X-acto Knife
- Other Materials: use what you have!
- Assorted colors of wax crayons, water soluble crayons, oil pastels, color pencils, china markers, charcoal, water color, acrylics, acrylic mediums....etc!
